

Edinburgh Vaccination Winter Programme 2022


- · 275,000 eligible adults

- 3 main sites; Waverley Mall, Gyle Shopping Centre, Ocean Terminal (all 7 days)
- · Seven additional weekend sites
- · Final adjustments to Ocean Terminal / Waverley Mall ongoing








4 approaches to absorbing new population

- Continue working closely with our 70 practices where growth is still possible
- New premises developed for an existing practice to expand or establishment of a new practice
- Innovation/re-design; Capital Medical Practice
- · Further adjustment of existing practice boundaries
- . Pressure acute in South East and centrally, with North East to follow.

Capital Medical Practice (CMP)


Innovation/Re-design

- Status quo is not meeting registration demand
- Existing practices already doing all they can
- Need to provide GMS to patients **not yet able** to register with a mainstream practice
- Agreement to develop feasibility proposal (31st March)
- Option for practices to close for 3 month periods
- -CMP: combination of remote capacity and face to face
- Patients on CMP to transfer to local practices as capacity becomes available
- -Implementation timetable to be confirmed

Practice Boundary adjustment

- · Many boundaries set decades ago and much too wide
- · Approximately 10% of population outside practice boundaries
- · Impact ranges from inconvenience to instability
- Started adjusting several years ago
- · CCs always consulted
- · Patients (understandably) reluctant to move their medical practice
- Patients have the right to remain, if they were within the practice boundary at time of registration
- Nobody can be moved against their wishes but this is no longer in our collective interests
